TOURNAMENTS - www.pickleballtournaments.com

For our members who are starting to spread their wings and play in some local tournaments, this may be helpful information for you to know.

There are 3 main types of tournaments:

1 - <u>Non-Sanctioned</u> tournaments - these are mainly local tournaments where a poster is sent around and people are asked to sign up (i.e. Towerpoint, Goodlife, etc.). You do not need a membership to play in these tournaments, just pay the registration & event fees 2 - <u>USAPA Sanctioned</u> tournaments (<u>www.pickleballtournaments.com</u>) - to play in these tournaments you MUST be a USAPA member. To join go to <u>www.usapa.org</u> and check out the membership tab. Your membership MUST be valid throughout the dates of the tournament you want to register in.

3 - SSIPA) - Tournament Play for 60+ Years Young!!

Some of these tournaments require a USAPA membership and some do not - this information would be on the website. (www.pickleballtournaments.com

SSIPA is the "new kid on the block" for tournament players who would rather play at their SKILL (3.0 - 5.0) level AND their AGE (60 - 80+) level. What do you get for your membership fee: the opportunity to play in their tournaments (four upcoming AZ tournaments - just look for the SSIPA logo), a wealth of information about their members and organization via Face Book, and a lot of like-minded players who have reached the age where they just want to have FUN!!! If you are still undecided whether to join or not, then usually there is a \$5.00 fee to play a SSIPA event in lieu of membership. Take it from someone who loves playing tournaments, SSIPA is a wonderful addition to the tournament experience. Jacquee Ware

As you can see, there are many opportunities for you to enjoy a competitive pickleball environment and maybe bring home some hardware or prizes. REMEMBER you can always play up a skill level, but never down a skill level if you have a USAPA rating. If you are self-rated, you can play where you feel you will be competitive and not be a 'sandbagger'. If you are playing in an age category, you can always play down but you CANNOT play up! Make sure you note when the registration dates for the tournament are, often they are months in advance of the actual tournament date. Also, if you are registering through www.pickleballtournaments.com you will need to register as a player at this site and create a profile.
