HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR A SCHEDULED EVENT?

If you would like to sign up for a scheduled event, email the coordinator (see 2021-22 ACTIVITY PROGRAM COORDINATORS link on the newsletter email) and email the coordinator to find out how to get on the list to participate. OR......click on the coordinators name on the schedule that is linked with the program (do this from the court schedule on the email link) and you will go right to their email. Remember you need to have registered as a MRPClub Member to participate. It is FREE to register and easy!!! Scan the QCODE above and it will take you right to the registration page. Or, go to our website listed above and there is a link to register.

SAFETY & FIRST AID AT THE COURTS

With close to 300 members this season at Mesa Regal so far, we need to make sure we are safe and prepared in case of an emergency on the courts. DID YOU KNOW, we have an AED machine on the pickleball patio on the wall by the door. As well, we have a white FIRST AID box on the fence near the crushed cans container (thanks for drinkingby the way...haha). This first aid box has all the supplies you need to attend to any 'road rash' you may receive while playing on the courts. Instructions are on the First Aid box that explain the process and address if calling 911 is necessary. As well, wearing your name badge allows us to find you and your emergency contact on our membership list. Ice packs are in the fridge freezer in the clubhouse kitchen. Knowing where all these things are and what to do in case of an emergency can help save lives and reduce injury. A huge THANKS to Sandy Radermacher for volunteering her time and ensuring all supplies are up to date and available to you if need be.

**If supplies are running out....please let Sandy or someone on the Board know about it so things can be restocked.

As well, after every rain the courts do need to be cleaned up so just pop by and grab a squeegee!!
