3.5 TRAINING - PLAY WITH A COACH - SUNDAYS

For those interested in the Sunday morning 3.5 training 10:30-12:30, there will be a signup sheet on the back bulletin board on December 30th. Fill in the following information: Name - email - site number Invites will be sent out to the 3.5 players by sign up genius, for Sunday January 8th. Look for your invite.

You need to be a resident of the park, a **registered** member of the club in good standing and have a club or other recognized rating of 3.5.

The focus of the training will center around the following basics: Athletic ready stance, court movement, Serve-return-3rd shot drop/drive-forehand/backhand ground stroke-lob (offense/defence) - resetting in the opportunity zone and of course dinking, forehand backhand). Strategies will include the X (whose shot is it?), red/yellow/green light, how you and your partner can move to the NVZ together plus a few other strategies.

We have 4 very qualified coaches signed up ready to go. If you are a 4.0 or higher and would like to be a part of the Sunday morning training , please speak with Lionel Fauchoux, our club training coordinator.




HINTS FOR PLAYING ON COURT WITH STRONGER OR WEAKER PLAYERS

And, those few outlined activities were the ONLY organized events on the schedule! The newsletter did emerge from the advice of the 2013-14 Secretary. When asked 'what is one thing the new Board can improve upon', it was suggested communication. So, the 2014-15 Board decided to start a newsletter and a membership list. Check out all the newsletters back to the start on the club website. Club Membership Numbers -

December 31, 2022 - 394 (we were at 290 this time last season...!) March 31, 2022 - 543 (remnants of covid....some of those Canadians sold...we want you back!) March 31, 2021 - 303 (covid year...where were those Canadians...lol) March 31, 2020 - 686 March 31, 2019 - 554 March 31, 2015 - 451 October 2014 - 205 (first membership list on EXCEL) Between 2015-2019, we just added new people to the membership list without removing those who did not return. So, exact membership numbers per season are not known.

Mesa Regal has 5 teams in the APPL League....' Arizona Pickleball Players League has been bringing team-based pickleball to regions across the state since the nonprofit's founding in 2019. Instead of costly tournaments that are hard to get into and require weekend-long commitments, APPL's unique team concept provides a more enjoyable way to experience the social, mental and physical benefits of pickleball. We wanted to fill the voids that we saw in other pickleball play structures.
