DID YOU KNOW THIS PICKLEBALL RULE? PLUS A QUICK TIP?



QUICK TIP - NO NEED TO RUSH!

Since most points are won at the non-volley-zone line, it is imperative that you work your way to there as soon as possible! However, make sure you are moving in to the kitchen line under control, which may mean that you could be forced to split step in the transition area. It is okay to take a few shots in order to make it all the way to the kitchen line. Pickleball players generally make errors in "no man's land" because they are trying to move in too much or too quickly. Reduce these errors by moving in under control and remaining calm in the transition area.

Did you know that pickleballtournaments.com and pickleballbrackets.com have merged and while tournaments will still be advertised on the pickleballtournaments.com website, registration and tournament software will be pickleballbrackets.com. This means that if you are looking for tournaments to participate in, you will need to create an account in pickleballbrackets.com (it is free) and register through this software.

REMEMBER...If the tournament you are signing up for is sanctioned, you MUST have a USA Pickleball membership to register. You also will need a pickleballbrackets.com account to register or see schedules of specific tournaments.
