PICKLEBALL MACHINE - THE LOBSTER

The MRPC has purchased a new Lobster ball machine for the membership to use to practice those shots you would love to get into your muscle memory!! Points to consider when wishing to sign out the Lobster ball machine:

 Court times reserved for Lobster ball machine are: Monday 2:30-4:30 Thursday 12:30-2:30



Please contact Tammy by text (775) 354-8381 to coordinate setting up the ball machine. A ball machine volunteer will be at each session to help you run the machine and suggest drill ideas. They may even be participating.

2. Members can reserve a court on their own on the MRPC website and sign out the Lobster ball machine by texting Tammy (775) 354-8381. Hours to reserve are 10:30am-6pm, if courts are available. Tammy will coordinate with a ball machine volunteer to get the machine out and give members a brief in service operation on the Lobster ball machine.

3. One member will be responsible for the condition and treatment of the ball machine. This member may be asked to use their driver's license as a deposit. You will be responsible for picking up the balls and returning them into the ball machine and or ball basket

- 4. Lobster ball machine safety is a serious concern.
- Please do not put fingers or hands in the front opening of the machine, or on the top.
- Do not stand in front of the machine.
- Be careful of the speed of the balls as the balls will travel quickly (up to 60 MPH)
- Be mindful of the balls around your feet when you are drilling. Make sure you keep the area under your feet clear of loose balls.

Wearing safety glasses is recommended.

PADDLES UP

KEEP DRINKING haha AND COLLECTING CANS

Collect and crush those cans then bring them down to the pickleball clubhouse where you can put add them to the aluminum can bin behind the golf driving range. NO PLASTICS OR GARBAGE in the bin PLEASE!!! All proceeds go towards keeping our club supplied in pickleballs!!

BALL ON COURT !! **Pickleball Safety Tips** STOP play immediately and replay the point. Be aware of your playing area & its obstacles Avoid backpedaling on the pickleball court Stretch & warm up your body before you play Wear proper court shoes & eye protection & use appropriate equip Know your body & give it enough rest Communicate with your partner to avoid confusion Improve your balance & learn to fall without injury Vear sunscreen & a hat when playing outdoors Avoid wet pickleball courts Hydrate! Work with a professional to Have a plan in case of improve your fundamentals an emerg ency on the court Help foster a safe & healthy pickleball community by following, and encouraging others to follow, these pickleball safety tips. 
HOW DO I GET MY NAME ON THE SCHEDULED PLAY LIST?

IS THAT PICKLEBALL IN or OUT ??

Did you know that this particular question has ruined a lot of friendships?....haha. Let's take a look at how DIFFICULT it is to call the ball in or out on the court.....and REVIEW the sportsmanship rule that if you are unsure or your call differs from your partners, the call goes to your opposition. FAIR, SPORTSMANLIKE play!!



From the above diagram, you can see there is a fine line for determining if a ball is actually 'in' or 'out'. The rule is that if you can see a gap between the ball and the line, the ball is 'out'. If you do not see a gap and can't determine if the ball is out, call it 'in'.
