LOBSTER BALL MACHINE USE GUIDELINES

- 1. Members can reserve a court on their own and sign out the Lobster ball machine by contacting Tammy 775-354-8381 by text. Hours to reserve are 10:30am-6pm. Tammy will coordinate with a ball machine volunteer to get the machine out and give members a brief in-service on the Lobster ball machine operation. Club members will be asked to forward the names of the people who will be involved in using the ball machine for that session. One member will be responsible for the condition and treatment of the ball machine. Before given the ball machine you will be asked name of person(s) using machine, day, time, and your phone number.
- 2. You will be responsible for picking up the balls and returning them into the ball machine.
- 3. A maximum of 6 club members or any combination there of can be included in the 1-hour reservation.
- 4. Please report any concerns (loud noise, inconsistent performance, etc.) by text to Larry Bowers 509-630-9391.
- 5. Lobster ball machine safety is a serious concern.
 - Please do not put fingers, hands in the front opening in the front of the machine, or on the top.
 - Do not stand in front of the machine.
 - Be careful of the speed of the balls as the balls will travel quickly (up to 60 MPH)
 - Be mindful of the balls around your feet when you are drilling. Make sure you keep the area under your feet clear of loose balls.
