### **SKILL LEVEL RATINGS - HOW TO GET RATED AT MESA REGAL**

Attached (and posted on the bulletin board) you will find the Mesa Regal Skill levels developed last year from the USAPA skill ratings. If you think you are at a 2.0 or 2.5 skill level, you can check with Pat Porter during a beginners night and he will help you determine which level you are. If you are not sure if you are a 3.0 or 3.5 skill level player, we will be having some specific times in the near future that you can be evaluated while playing with 3.0 or 3.5 players. A sure way to determine your rating is to go into a skill level tournament in a specific level and see how you do. If you are winning 3.5 tournaments, USAPA or the tournament director will move you up to a 4.0. For upper level players this is how their skill levels are determined.

We are also happy to report that Mesa Regal has added screening to Courts 6 & 7 that provide shade on the benches while watching or waiting to play. ## COURT ETIQUETTE - OPEN PLAY GUIDELINES & RESERVATIONS

Our courts are getting busier and it seems a good time to review the Open Play Guidelines to make sure all members understand the format. Attached please find the poster that will be going up on the courts as a reminder for Open Play.

There are 3 court designations during Open Play in the mornings.

**Courts 1 & 2 - Beginners** Beginners use the paddle rack on patio for rotation in. After 2 games players come off court and place paddles back in rack. If beginners are not waiting, Court 3-5 Intermediates can rotate into one of the courts. If only two beginners are waiting, Court 3-5 Intermediates are invited to join them to make a foursome.

**Courts 3-5 - Intermediates** Intermediates use the paddle rack on patio for rotation in. Please join with beginners if there are not enough beginners to make a foursome. If no one is waiting to play on courts 6 & 7, a foursome from patio can rotate into these courts.

**Courts 6 & 7 - Upper Intermediates Aggressive** Paddles are placed in order to play on the fence at back of courts. If no one is waiting, Courts 3-5 Intermediates can join rotation onto courts until such time as more aggressive players arrive to play. NOTE: if courts 6 & 7 are busy, players play one game only and rotate. This is by consensus at the courts so check on protocol at the time if playing on these courts. We are planning to put a sign on these courts that will indicate if one or two game rotation so all playing are aware of the process when they arrive at the courts.

Always remember that not everyone who plays at our club is aware of the process so please be respectful when sharing information about our club and open play rotation. Thanks to all of you for your help in making Open Play fun for everyone!!
