If there are only 2 beginners with paddles in the rack, please join them for a game, it would great for them to get some friendly mentoring. Also, remember, if you are a beginner and playing on the beginner's courts (1 & 2) the court guidelines posted on each of the courts should be followed. Once you finish two games you are to come off if there are paddles waiting in the rack, either intermediate or beginner, the next 4 rotate in giving preference to the waiting beginners. The idea is to share the court space so if you have played your 2 games it is your turn to sit off.

Also as a reminder NO COURTS CAN BE RESERVED DURING OPEN PLAY TIME. Thanks to everyone for their respectful cooperation with our court guidelines.
