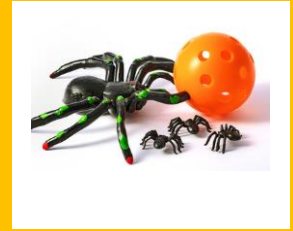

SKILL LEVEL RATINGS - WHAT ARE THEY AND WHAT DO THEY MEAN?

You will notice you have a choice of 5 different 'RATING SOURCE's on your online registration. MRPC (you have been rated by one of our club raters), USAPA (this is a rating you have received from USAPickleball sanctioned tournaments, SELF RATED (you have no other official rating), WPR (World Pickleball Ratings derived from pickleballtournaments.com matches played since January 2020), PCO (Pickleball Canada Organization Rating).

REMEMBER...If the tournament you are signing up for is sanctioned, you **MUST** have a USAPickleball membership to register. www.usapickleball.org and look under memberships.
